LIMASSOL - OMODOS VILLAGE - WINERY (every Monday)

- Pick up from hotels in Protaras 08:00 - 08:25 (please see our pick-up lists for the exact pick-up time from each pick-up point)
- Pick up from hotels in Ayia Napa 08:30 - 08:55
- Pick up from hotels in Larnaca 09:10 - 09:25
- Coffee break near Chirokitia village (approx. 20 mins)
- Short orientation by the guide in Limassol Old Town and then free time for sightseeing, shopping, etc. (approx. 1 hour and 30 mins)
- Visit at Ktima Gerolemo Winery in Omodos for wine tasting (approx. 1 hour)
- Wine tasting is included in the excursion price. Wine tasting includes 6 types of wines and zivania (the famous traditional Cypriot spirit also known as “firewater”)
- Guiding and free time at Omodos village for lunch (lunch is an optional extra not included in the price), sightseeing, shopping, etc. (approx. 1 hour and 45 mins)
- Estimated return: in Larnaca around 17:30, Ayia Napa around 18:15 and Protaras around 18:45

Note: Visitors must dress appropriately when visiting religious places. No tank tops or shorts allowed for men or women inside the Holy Cross Monastery!

PAFOS & CURIUM (every Monday)

- Pick up from hotels in Protaras 07:00 - 07:25 (please see our pick-up lists for the exact pick-up time from each pick-up point)
- Pick up from hotels in Ayia Napa 07:30 - 07:55
- Pick up from hotels in Larnaca 08:10 - 08:25
- Coffee break near Chirokitia village (approx. 20 mins)
- Guiding in the archeological site of ancient Curium (approx. 45 mins). Entrance fees for Curium are included in the excursion price.
- Free time in Pafos Harbour for sightseeing, shopping, etc. and lunch (lunch is an optional extra not included in the price) (approx. 2 hours and 15 mins).
- An optional guiding at the mosaics in the House of Dionysus is also offered during this stop (entrance fees for the House of Dionysus are not included in the price - €4.50 for adults and free for children up to 16 years old)
- Short stop at Geroskipou village at a traditional Cyprus Delights shop (approx. 20 mins)
- Free time at the Rock / Birthplace of Aphrodite for photos and swimming (approx. 45 mins)
- Estimated return: in Larnaca around 17.00, Ayia Napa around 17.45 and Protaras around 18.15

Note: Clients can bring swimwear and towels with them, if they would like to swim at the Rock of Aphrodite!

FAMAGUSTA & SALAMIS (every Wednesday & Sunday)

- Pick up from hotels in Protaras 07:40 - 08:05
 - Pick up from hotels in Ayia Napa 08:10 - 08:30
 - Pick up from hotels in Larnaca 07:45 - 08:05
- (please see our pick-up lists for the exact pick-up time from each pick-up point)

*****(For this excursion please inform clients staying in hotels in Larnaca that in the morning they will be transferred to the excursion bus with a mini bus. In the afternoon, again they will be transferred from the excursion bus back to Larnaca with a mini bus. The mini bus transfers are free of charge)**

- Enter the border through Strovilia (Vrysoulles) checkpoint
- Free time at the “Golden Beach” of Famagusta for swimming or for a walk around the newly opened part of Varosha, which also known as the “Ghost Town”. This is the fenced, sealed-off area of Famagusta. (approx. 1 hour)

- Visit at the archeological site of Salamis and at Saint Barnabas church and tomb (Optional Extra)
The visit at these two places is an optional extra. Clients can decide on the day of the excursion if they want to visit these two places. Clients that do not want to visit these two places are dropped off in Famagusta Old Town Center where they can have extra 2 hours free time.

- Guiding at the archeological site of Salamis (approx. 40 mins) and guiding at Saint Barnabas church and tomb (approx. 30 mins).
- The entrance fees for these two sites (€6 for adults / free for children up to 12 years old) are not included in the excursion price. Clients pay for these entrance fees on the day of the excursion. The entrance fees can be paid only in cash in euro – no credit cards!

- Free time in Famagusta Old Town Center for sightseeing and lunch (lunch is an optional extra not included in the price)

(Clients that decide to visit Salamis and Saint Barnabas will have approx. 2 hours free time in Famagusta Old Town Center)

(Clients that decide not to visit Salamis and Saint Barnabas will have approx. 4 hours free time in Famagusta Old Town Center)

- Short drive on the bus next to Varosha, also known as the “Ghost Town”
- Exit the border through Deryneia checkpoint
- Estimated return: in Larnaca around 17.00, Ayia Napa around 16.30 and Protaras around 16.00

Notes:

- Clients can bring swimwear and towels with them, if they would like to swim at the “Golden Beach”!
- Clients must have with them their Passports or their EU National Identity (ID) Cards! Only the citizens of European Union Countries are allowed to use their National Identity (ID) Cards to cross the checkpoint. All other nationalities must use their Passports for crossing. Only original documents can be used for crossing. Photocopies of the original documents, or other forms of identification (e.g., driving licenses, temporary residence permits, etc.) cannot be used for crossing.
- Armenian, Syrian, Nigerian, Turkmenistan, Bangladesh and Nepal citizens cannot join this excursion, unless they have a special visa!

KERYNIA & FAMAGUSTA (every Friday)

- Pick up from hotels in Protaras 07:40 - 08:05
 - Pick up from hotels in Ayia Napa 08:10 - 08:30
 - Pick up from hotels in Larnaca 07:45 - 08:05
- (please see our pick-up lists for the exact pick-up time from each pick-up point)

*****(For this excursion please inform clients staying in hotels in Larnaca that in the morning they will be transferred to the excursion bus with a mini bus. In the afternoon, again they will be transferred from the excursion bus back to Larnaca with a mini bus. The mini bus transfers are free of charge)**

- Enter the border through Strovilia (Vrysoulles) checkpoint
- Guiding at the gothic Bellapais Abbey (approx. 45 mins)
- Free time in Kerynia Harbour for sightseeing and lunch (lunch is an optional extra not included in the price) (approx. 2 hours). During this time clients can visit Kerynia Castle with the guide. The entrance ticket for Kerynia Castle is included in the excursion price.
- Free time in Famagusta Old Town Center for sightseeing (approx. 1 hour)
- Short drive on the bus next to Varosha, also known as the “Ghost Town”
- Exit the border through Deryneia checkpoint
- Estimated return: in Larnaca around 18.00, Ayia Napa around 18.00 and Protaras around 17.30

Notes:

- Clients must have with them their Passports or their EU National Identity (ID) Cards! Only the citizens of European Union Countries are allowed to use their National Identity (ID) Cards to cross the checkpoint. All other nationalities must use their Passports for crossing. Only original documents can be used for crossing. Photocopies of the original documents, or other forms of identification (e.g., driving licenses, temporary residence permits, etc.) cannot be used for crossing.

- Armenian, Syrian, Nigerian, Turkmenistan, Bangladesh and Nepal citizens cannot join this excursion, unless they have a special visa!

- Ukrainian citizens living in Cyprus with a refugee status cannot join this excursion as they are not allowed to cross the border.

TROODOS MOUNTAINS & NICOSIA (every Tuesday & Saturday)

- Pick up from hotels in Protaras 07:00 - 07:25
 - Pick up from hotels in Ayia Napa 07:30 - 07:55
 - Pick up from hotels in Larnaca 08:10 - 08:25
- (please see our pick-up lists for the exact pick-up time from each pick-up point)

- Free time in Nicosia Old Town Center for sightseeing (approx. 1 hour)
- Guiding and free time in Kakopetria village (approx. 45 mins)
- Free time in Troodos Mountains Square for lunch (lunch is an optional extra not included in the price) (approx. 1 hour and 15 mins)
- Guiding and free time in the Holy Cross Monastery and the traditional wine press in Omodos village (approx. 1 hour)
- Estimated return: in Larnaca around 17.00, Ayia Napa around 17.45 and Protaras around 18.15

Note: Visitors must dress appropriately when visiting religious places. No tank tops or shorts allowed for men or women inside the Holy Cross Monastery!

NICOSIA CITY TOUR (every Thursday)

- Pick up from hotels in Protaras 08:00 - 08:25 (please see our pick-up lists for the exact pick-up time from each pick-up point)
- Pick up from hotels in Ayia Napa 08:30 - 08:55
- Pick up from hotels in Larnaca 09:10 - 09:25

- Free time at the Cyprus Handicraft Center (approx. 30 mins)
- Short drive on the bus around Nicosia Town Center with guiding of the main landmarks of the town along the way (approx. 30 mins)
- Short orientation by the guide in Nicosia Old Town (approx. 30 mins) and then free time without the guide (approx. 3 hours) for sightseeing, shopping, etc. and lunch (lunch is an optional extra not included in the price) (approx. 3 hours and 30 mins total in Nicosia Old Town Center)
- Estimated return: in Larnaca around 15.30, Ayia Napa around 16.15 and Protaras around 16.45

Notes:

- Clients must have with them their Passports or their EU National Identity (ID) Cards, if they would like to visit the Turkish Occupied part of Nicosia during their free time! Only the citizens of European Union Countries are allowed to use their National Identity (ID) Cards to cross the checkpoint. All other nationalities must use their Passports for crossing. Only original documents can be used for crossing. Photocopies of the original documents, or other forms of identification (e.g., driving licenses, temporary residence permits, etc.) cannot be used for crossing.

- Armenian, Syrian, Nigerian, Turkmenistan, Bangladesh and Nepal citizens cannot cross the checkpoint, unless they have a special visa!

- Ukrainian citizens living in Cyprus with a refugee status are not allowed to cross the checkpoint.

- Greek citizens that have the old National Identity (ID) Cards which are handwritten with a pen, cannot cross the checkpoint. Greek citizens must have with them either a new National Identity (ID) Card or their Passport to be allowed to cross the border.

KYKKOS MONASTERY & KAKOPETRIA VILLAGE (every Thursday)

- Pick up from hotels in Protaras 07:00 - 07:25 (please see our pick-up lists for the exact pick-up time from each pick-up point)
- Pick up from hotels in Ayia Napa 07:30 - 07:55
- Pick up from hotels in Larnaca 07:45 - 08:05

*******(For this excursion please inform clients staying in hotels in Larnaca that in the morning they will be transferred to the excursion bus with a mini bus. In the afternoon, again they will be transferred from the excursion bus back to Larnaca with a mini bus. The mini bus transfers are free of charge)

- Coffee break near Astromeritis (approx. 20 mins)
- Guiding and free time in the traditional mountain village of Kakopetria (approx. 45 mins)
- Guiding and free time in Throni (tomb of Archbishop Makarios) (approx. 30 mins)
- Guiding in Kykkos Monastery and free time for lunch (lunch is optional extra not included in the price) (approx. 1 hour and 45 mins)
- Estimated return: in Larnaca around 17.00, Ayia Napa around 17.45 and Protaras around 18.15

Note: Visitors must dress appropriately when visiting religious places. No tank tops or shorts allowed for men or women at Throni and Kykkos Monastery!

LEFKARA VILLAGE - DONKEY FARM - CAMEL PARK (every Saturday)

- Pick up from hotels in Protaras 08:00 - 08:25
 - Pick up from hotels in Ayia Napa 08:30 - 08:55
 - Pick up from hotels in Larnaca 09:10 - 09:25
- (please see our pick-up lists for the exact pick-up time from each pick-up point)

- Guiding and free time at Lefkara village (approx. 1 hour and 30 mins)
- Free time at the “Golden Donkeys” farm in Skarinou village (approx. 1 hour)

The farm includes a traditional Cypriot House, poultry, goats, a shop with donkey milk and olive oil products.

- The entrance fees for the Donkey Farm are included in the excursion price.
- Donkey ride is an optional extra and it is not included in the excursion price.

The price of the optional donkey ride is €12 for adults. One child can ride with the adult for free (weight restrictions apply). For two children the price of the donkey ride is €12 for both children.

- Free time at the “Camel Park” in Mazotos village (approx. 2 hours)

The park has a wide variety of animals (ponies, horses, ostriches, lemurs and a small aquarium). It also includes other facilities - swimming pool, restaurant, kids’ area, bumper cars, mini train ride, swings, mirror room and coin operated rides.

- The entrance fees for the Camel Park are included in the excursion price.
- Lunch is an optional extra and it is not included in the excursion price.
- Camel ride is an optional extra and it is not included in the excursion price.

The price of the optional camel ride is €7 for adults and €5 for children.

- Estimated return: in Larnaca around 16:00, Ayia Napa around 16:45 and Protaras around 17:15

Note: Clients can bring swimwear and towels with them, if they would like to swim at the Camel Park swimming pool!
