
Join us for one of our most popular trips and discover the natural beauty of Troodos Mountains, traditional villages and Nicosia - the last divided city in the world!

First, we drive to the capital city of the island Nicosia where you will have some free time for a coffee break, or to stroll around the Walled Old Town Center, or to walk up to the "Green Line"- the border that divides Nicosia into two since the Turkish invasion in 1974.

As we drive towards Troodos Mountains, we stop at Kakopetria, a well-preserved village with traditional picturesque houses. There you will get the chance to walk around the quaint little village known for its running waters and mini waterfall and mingle with the friendly locals. We continue towards the peak of Troodos Mountains, where the forest stretches as far as the eye can see. We stop at Troodos Square, the highest point of Troodos Mountains, where free time will be given for lunch (optional extra). Situated right in the heart of the island, this location offers some of the most breathtaking views in Cyprus.

Following lunch you can experience one of the highlights of this excursion, the beautiful traditional village of Omodos. The village is built around the Holy Cross monastery, one of the oldest and most sacred monasteries in the island. Omodos is a famous wine producing village with lots of small shops that you can visit during your free time to taste and buy some of the best local Cypriot wine and other handmade products.

Visitors must dress appropriately when visiting religious places. No tank tops or shorts allowed for men or women at the Holy Cross Monastery!





Pafos & Curium








Visit the western part of Cyprus and travel back in time to discover the rich history of the island which is interconnected to Greek history and mythology!

Our first stop is Ancient Curium, one of the most important archeological sites on the island. There you will have the chance to see the Greco-Roman theater where gladiator games were held and the House of Eustolios with its mosaics and bath establishments. The site sits on a 100-meter hill right next to the sea and offers breathtaking views of the coast of Episkopi Bay.

We then drive to the town of **Pafos** where you will have the chance to visit the **House of Dionysus**, which is famous for its **ancient mosaics** (optional extra). You will also have free time to relax, have lunch (optional extra) and enjoy the area surrounding **Pafos Harbour**, which is one of the most visited and beautiful tourist resorts of the island.

Driving back from Pafos, we stop at **Geroskipou village** where you can **taste and buy traditional sweet Cyprus delights**, a local delicacy made there since 1895.

Our final stop is at the Rock of Aphrodite which is the legendary birthplace of Aphrodite, Greek goddess of beauty and love. According to Greek mythology, as soon as Aphrodite was created from the foam of the sea, although she had originally begun drifting towards the Greek island of Cythera, the wind blew her towards her spiritual home near Pafos. According to ancient legends, anyone that swims around the Rock of Aphrodite is blessed with eternal beauty! Time is given there for photos and swimming before we drive back to the east coast of the island.

A unique day out that gives you the chance to drive by timeless traditional villages, to enjoy scenic views at the Troodos Mountains area and to visit the two largest and most beautiful cities of the island!

First, we drive to the capital city of the island Nicosia where you will have some free time for a coffee break, or to stroll around the Walled Old Town Center, or to walk up to the "Green Line" - the border that divides Nicosia into two since the Turkish invasion in 1974.


We then continue our journey driving towards Troodos Mountains and we stop at Virgin Mary of Asinou Church (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) built in the 12th century. The interior of the church is covered with beautiful painted frescoes that will take your breath away.

Our next stop is Troodos Mountains Square, the highest point of the mountains, where free time will be given for lunch (optional extra). Situated right in the green heart of the island, this location offers some of the most breathtaking mountain views in Cyprus.

The return journey will take you through Limassol, the second largest town of the island, where you will have some free time to relax or to explore this beautiful coastal town.

Visitors must dress appropriately when visiting religious places. No tank tops or shorts allowed for men and women at Virgin Mary of Asinou church!

Travel through the beautiful Troodos Mountains area, enjoy scenic mountain views and visit Kykkos Monastery, the wealthiest and most lavish monastery on the island!

Our first stop is Kakopetria, a well-preserved village with traditional picturesque houses. There you will get the chance to walk around the quaint little village known for its running waters and mini waterfall and mingle with the friendly locals.


Driving through the mountains we then stop at Throni, which is located on the top of the mountain amongst a beautiful pine forest. This location offers breathtaking and scenic views of Troodos Mountains. There you will also have the chance to visit the tomb of Archbishop Makarios III. the first President of Cyprus.

We then drive to Kykkos Monastery, founded by the Byzantines in 1092. It is dedicated to Virgin Mary and it is the richest monastery on the island. It also possesses one of the three surviving icons painted by Saint Luke.

This miraculous icon, which is covered in silver gilt and is enclosed in a shrine of tortoise shell and mother-of-pearl, holds an eminent position in the church. Free time will be given to visit the monastery and to have lunch (optional extra).

NOTE:

Visitors must dress appropriately when visiting religious places. No tank tops or shorts allowed for men and women at Throni and Kykkos Monastery!



Our first stop is Famagusta Old Town Center where free time is given to enjoy the surroundings of this beautiful coastal town, which is famous for its golden sandy beaches, its Old Venetian Walls and the Gothic Church of Saint Nicholas.

Driving through Pentadaktilos Mountain range, we arrive at Bellapais Abbey, which is a masterpiece of Gothic Art! Its construction was completed in the 13th century by the White Canons, a Roman Catholic religious order founded by Saint Norbert. The Abbey offers breathtaking views of the coast of Kerynia and a pleasant atmosphere of tranquility.

Our final stop is in the northern end of the island at the town of Kerynia, a city with more than 3000 years of Greek history. Plenty of free time is given for lunch (optional extra) and sightseeing. There you can visit the picturesque Harbour and the Castle of Kerynia (optional extra), which hosts the remains of one of the oldest shipwrecks in the world. On the way back we drive next to Varosha, also known as the 'Ghost Town'. This is the fenced, sealed-off area of the town of Famagusta which remains abandoned and trapped in a time-lock since the Turkish invasion in Cyprus, in 1974.

NOTES:

- · Passports or European Union Identity Cards are needed on the day of the excursion.
- For this excursion, clients staying in Larnaca area are transferred to and back from the excursion bus near Agia Napa with a mini bus, free of charge.







Visit the beautiful coastal town of Famagusta and other important sites of interest nearby. Explore part of Varosha, also known as the "Ghost Town" and swim at one of the most beautiful beaches of the island! Our first stop is at the beach of Varosha, also known as the "Ghost Town". There you will have the chance to swim in the crystal-clear blue waters of the beautiful golden sand beach of Famagusta, whilst taking in the eerie sight of the abandoned buildings which have been desolate since the Turkish invasion in 1974. You can also explore part of the abandoned "Ghost Town" that opened for the public for the first time after 46 years in 2020.










We then drive to Famagusta Old Town Center, where free time will be given for lunch (optional extra) and sightseeing. During your free time there, we highly recommend a walk around the Venetian Walls that surround the old part of the town and a visit at the Gothic Church of Saint Nicolas and Othello Castle, which is mentioned by William Shakespeare in his play "Othello" (optional extra). On the way back we drive along the fenced, sealed-off area of the "Ghost Town". Once one of the most famous tourist destinations in the Mediterranean, this area now remains abandoned and trapped in a time-lock.

NOTES:

- Passports or European Union Identity Cards are needed on the day of the excursion.
- The entrance fees for Saint Barnabas and Salamis are not included in the price and can be paid (in cash only) on the day of the excursion.
- Clients that do not wish to visit Saint Barnabas and Salamis can have extra free time in Famagusta Old Town Center.
- For this excursion, clients staying in Larnaca area are transferred to and back from the excursion bus near Agia Napa with a mini bus, free of charge.



The trip starts with a visit at **Lefkara village**, one of the most beautiful and traditional villages in the island, famous for its traditional handicrafts of lace embroidery and filigree silver. Legend has it that the famous painter, Leonardo da Vinci himself visited the village in 1481 and bought a lace altar cloth, which he donated to the Milan Cathedral. The character of the village is very picturesque with narrow winding streets and traditional terracotta-roofed houses. Interesting sites to visit include the Folklore Museum, the old fountain and the old olive mill. The village also has beautiful ancient chapels, including Holy Cross and Archangel Michael, with frescoes that date back to the 12th and 15th centuries.

The next stop of this trip is the "Golden Donkeys" farm in Skarinou village that includes a traditional Cypriot House, poultry, goats, a shop with donkey milk and olive oil products. You can also enjoy a Donkey ride (optional extra) in the beautiful surroundings of the farm. The last stop is the "Camel Park" in Mazotos village which has variety of animals (ponies, horses, ostriches, lemurs) and a small aquarium. The park also includes a swimming pool, restaurant, kids' area, bumper cars, mini train ride, swings, mirror room and coin operated rides. You also have the chance to ride the camels and to have lunch (optional extras).

The best way to do your shopping and sightseeing in the capital town of Cyprus! First, we make a brief stop at the Cyprus Handicraft Center in Nicosia, an outlet for producing and selling traditional folk art and crafts. You can then enjoy a short drive around Nicosia town center during which you get the chance to see some of the most important landmarks of the capital. We then drop you off inside the Walled Old Town Center, where you get lots of free time for shopping and lunch (optional extra) and to explore the town! During your free time there, you also have the chance to cross the barrier (also known as the "Green Line") that divides the Cypriot capital city of Nicosia into the southern Greek-Cypriot region and the northern Turkish-Cypriot region since the Turkish invasion in 1974. The Turkish occupied part of Nicosia that remains in a time-lock also has many interesting places to visit.

NOTE:

Do not forget to take your passports or European Union Identity cards with you, if you want to visit both sides of the last divided city in the world.

The first stop of this trip is in Limassol, the second largest town in Cyprus, where you will have lots of free time for sightseeing, shopping and to explore! Driving towards the foothills of Troodos Mountains. we then stop at **Ktima Gerolemo Winery near Omodos village for wine tasting.** The wine tasting which is included in the excursion price includes six types of wines and zivania (a traditional Cypriot spirit also known as "firewater"). The final stop is at the picturesque wine making village of **Omodos** for lunch (optional extra), sightseeing and shopping. Despite its small size, Omodos has many interesting places to visit! Located within close proximity of one another are the cobbled square, old stone-built houses, local wineries, a Medieval wine press and the Monastery of Holy Cross with its beautiful religious icons and woodcarvings. Inside the monastery you can also visit a museum dedicated to the National Liberation Struggle, a center for the preservation of narrow-knit lacing, and an Icon Museum.
